measurement and regulation of critical infrastructures through secure data transmission – whether designed as redundancy or as primary path. EuroSkyPark solutions offer a high level of security and are sustainable – also due to their long service life. The technology has already been tried and tested in many offshore projects and can become the standard in the offshore sector thanks to its high transmission reliability and performance.
